

Redirect your tax dollars!

My Fellow Rural Americans,

Over the years Meadowbrook Park has been able to grow, maintain, restore and provide facilities for the people of the region. We have done this by creative grant writing and sound management of our assets. But with the advent of the mandated sewer project we have suddenly fallen into a situation where we are facing massive debt for a government decree that is using up all our regular resources. We have been shut out of the stimulus money, and the grants are becoming more selective and skewed to large population areas (more votes) leaving small rural communities with fewer opportunities.

There is a way for rural America to “vote” with their tax dollars.

By using the program put together by the people at “Bigger, Faster, Stronger”, a national athletic fitness business, to help schools and organizations raise money for their causes, we can begin to look toward building an endowment to benefit Meadowbrook Park.

Congress in their “green energy” development program is allowing tax credits for people who purchase equipment in the “green energy” sector of the economy. These tax credits and the resulting depreciation of the equipment amount to a credit of \$1.50 for each dollar spent on “green energy” equipment.

Look at your payroll stub and see how much you are having deducted for federal income taxes and plug that into the RAPower3 energy equipment. Revise your W-4 to withhold less of your income for taxes. As a result you will have spent no out of pocket money because use used your income tax withholding and you will gain a tax credit for the amount you spent.

The result is a tax credit for you for purchasing “green energy” equipment and a depreciation credit for that equipment to save you more tax dollars. You also will be helping Meadowbrook Park by purchasing the “green energy” equipment as it receives a commission on each sale that goes into the endowment fund. This program is better than the one time credit you can get for a new water heater. This program is good until the year 2016. If you need tax credits and want to help out Meadowbrook Park, this is a good choice.

If we can get 200 people to purchase one unit of generation equipment each year for the next 4 years, we can build the endowment to over one million dollars.
